August & September Holidays

The civic holiday will be observed on **Monday, August 5th** and Labour Day on **Monday September 2**. There will be no delivery service on those days. The on-call vet will be available for emergencies. Both clinics will be open only in the mornings (7am – 12pm) on the Saturdays and the holiday Mondays for pick-ups and early residue tests.

Message from Public Health for Private Drinking Water Well Owners: Public Health recommends that you test your well water for bacteria 3 times per year, Fall, Spring and Summer; and fluoride and nitrates at least once.

Responsible Sharps Disposal

Linwood Vet is registered with the Ministry of the Environment in order to have a waste service dispose of our sharps waste. To assist you to properly dispose of your sharps, we will accept your sharps in Linwood Vet Service prepaid containers. Just order one and send it back, when full. We can **only** accept sharps (needles, syringes, blades) in these containers, and they can **only** be filled to the fill line, not the top of the container. No vaccine or medicines can be in the sharps container.
